Board Meeting Minutes Of August 14, 2024

Regular Board Meeting called to order at 5:31 pm by Chairman Derrick Davis at Valpico Memorial Park.

<u>Minutes</u>: The Regular Session Meeting Minutes and Closed Session Meeting of July 10, 2024, were approved by motion of Vice-Chair Arganbright second by Trustee Tobeck, motion passed unanimous.

<u>Financial Report</u>: Financial reports for June 2024 were approved by motion of Trustee Tobeck, second by Trustee Kaska, motion passed unanimous.

<u>Pre-Need Account</u>: The cash amount of pre-paid interment rights and services used (Schulte) for the month of July 2024, \$10,120.00. The cash amount of pre-paid interment rights and services used (Valpico) for the month of July 2024, \$3,050.00.

Review of Warrants: Warrants of July 9, 2024, July 19, 2024, and July 25, 2024, were approved by motion of Trustee Tobeck, second by, Vice-Chair Arganbright, motion passed unanimous.

- 1. District Polices: Nothing to Report
- Ordinance: Vice Chair Arganbright asked what is needed to be able to have unruly people cited for not
 following the cemetery rules. Brian Hughes from Best Best and Krieger offered to look into getting an ordinance
 in place. Update at next meeting.
- 3. <u>District Medical/Dental and Vision:</u> Manager Warner reported that both medical from CalPERS and Delta Dental and VSP Vision from Golden State Risk Management Authority will start on September 1, 2024.
- 4. <u>Schulte Niche Repairs:</u> Manager Warner reported that she has not heard back from Tony Charondo regarding the niches. The groundskeepers put boards and cones up to cover the area. Update at next meeting.
- 5. 1st and 2nd Quarter 2024 Bank Withdraws from Oak Valley Community Bank Manager Warner reported the bank withdrawals that have been done and deposited in the accounts as follows:

A. Schulte Memorial Park:

Speed Bumps: Manager Warner Reported the speed bumps were installed at the Tracy Public Cemetery. A.O. Jones came out a second time to repaint all speed bumps with a second coat of white paint. This project is complete.

B. Valpico Memorial Park:

<u>ADA Compliant for Modular Home:</u> Manager Warner reported she has not received any new quotes. She will contact Swenson Construction to get as a quote. Update at next meeting.

<u>Valpico Expansion</u>: As per the boards request Manager Warner has found all documentation in regards to the first phase of Valpico Memorial Park, in order to begin discussions on phase 2.

<u>Pre-Pour Foundation's Section 4</u>: Manager Warner reported in section 4 the district should convert this section to be back-to-back burials and to have pre-pour cement foundations placed. This would make it easier for our groundskeepers to dig for burials, weed eating, mowing and day to day maintenance of the grounds. The Board of Trustees would like for Manager Warner to get quotes for pre-pour cement foundations. Update at next meeting.
